

The Proposal

Clanmil Housing, and our development partner, MJ McBride Construction, is proposing to deliver 47 new social homes at 285-291 Antrim Road, Glengormley. The Proposal includes 10 family maisonettes and 37 apartments for general needs and people aged over 55.



The new development will include:

- 6 No. 1 Bedroom Apartments
- 21 No. 2 Bedroom Apartments
- 10 No. 2 Bedroom Maisonettes
- 1 No. 1 Bedroom Apartment for people aged 55 and over
- 6 No. 2 Bedroom Apartments for people aged 55 and over
- 3 No. 2 Bedroom Wheelchair Apartments

We are currently facing a housing crisis with social housing waiting lists at c50,000 – the highest they have been in 10 years. In that context we are exploring the opportunity to deliver 47 new homes on the Antrim Road, Glengormley.
