



CLANMIL HOUSING - FACT SHEET

- Clanmil Housing's purpose is to provide homes for people to live well.
- Clanmil Housing Association was first registered with the Department of the Environment in March 1977. It was known as the Royal British Legion Housing Association at that time.
- In 1996, Government transferred provision of social rented housing from the NI Housing Executive to Northern Ireland's housing associations and Clanmil Housing was launched.
- Clanmil has over 6,000 homes including:
 - family housing
 - independent living schemes for older people
 - housing with care for frail older people
 - supported housing for people with mental health problems and learning difficulties
 - supported housing for people with dementia
 - group housing for Irish Travellers.
- Clanmil owns and manages properties throughout Northern Ireland.
- Over 11,400 people live in homes provided by Clanmil.
- Clanmil is one of Northern Ireland's largest housing associations and a major player in residential development.
- Clanmil is based in the Northern Whig building in Waring Street, Belfast.
- Clanmil employs over 300 people.
- Clanmil's Group Chief Executive is Carol McTaggart Adv Dip CIHCM MCMI.
